## Dress Code Requirements

### Ballet

#### Beginning Levels

- black leotard of any style
- flesh tone footed tights
- flesh tone flat ballet shoes

#### Pointe Class

- black leotard of any style
- flesh tone footed or convertible tights
- flesh tone flat ballet shoes
- pointe shoes with approval
- ballet pink pull-on skirt optional
- black no-tie shrug optional

#### Male Ballet Dancers

- black or white tight-fit t-shirt or tank
- black tights
- black ballet flats
- dance belt

#### Intermediate Levels

- black leotard of any style
- flesh tone footed tights
- flesh tone flat ballet shoes
- white pull-on skirt optional

#### Advanced Class

- black leotard of any style
- flesh tone footed or convertible tights
- flesh tone flat ballet shoes
- pointe shoes with approval
- black wrap skirt optional
- black no-tie shrug optional

### Electives

#### Hip Hop/Break

all attire must be black, gray, white, or teal

- athletic attire (fitted joggers, athletic shorts, etc.)
- flat-bottom CLEAN sneakers (no outside shoes)

#### Contemporary/Acro

all attire must be black, gray, or white

- black leotard OR black, white, or gray fitted top
- black leggings
- black dance shorts with flesh tone tights
- close-toed contemporary shoes
- knee-pads recommended for Contemporary 3

#### Tap/Jazz/Broadway

all attire must be black, gray, or white

- black leotard OR black, white, or gray fitted top
- black leggings OR black dance shorts with flesh tone tights
- black jazz shoes
- black tap shoes with screws (no nails)

### Hair & Jewelry

No jewelry in class with the exception of small stud earrings (under instructor discretion). No jewelry of any kind will be allowed onstage, including new piercings.

#### Ballet

Hair must be in a secure ballet bun (see our website for tutorial). Short hair (above the shoulders) must be pulled back securely away from the face with a headband or clips.

#### Electives

Hair must be tied securely away from the face in a bun, ponytail or braid(s). Short hair must be pulled back securely away from the face with a headband or clips.
